
IN SUPPORT OF THE PRESERVATION OF THE CORNELL COOPERATIVE EXTENSION  
BUILDING AT THE ESSEX COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS

WHEREAS the Cornell Cooperative Extension Building and other buildings of the Essex County Fairgrounds, in the Town of Westport, Essex County, New York are an important group of architecturally and historically significant buildings listed on the National Register of Historic Places;

WHEREAS the Cornell Cooperative Extension Building has always been at the center of Essex County agricultural activity and central to the important role that the Fairgrounds plays in these activities;

WHEREAS the Cornell Cooperative Extension Building has great potential as a cultural, economic, educational and recreational resource for future of the Fairgrounds, the local area, the Adirondack North Country region, and for the people of New York State and beyond;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Adirondack Architectural Heritage, the private nonprofit, historic preservation organization for the Adirondack region, supports the preservation and rehabilitation of the Cornell Cooperative Extension Building and opposes its demolition and replacement with a new building.
